Notice of Races

Yachts competing for the Lake Charlevoix Cup may do so by completing the registration form and paying the appropriate fee. Competitors will also need to register and compete in the following regattas as outlined in the instructions listed below.

Mark Madness Regatta sponsored by BCYC at Boyne City on June 13 & June 14

5 races scheduled; 2 races will be scored

Will count first race on Saturday and first race on Sunday. In the event either days sailing is cancelled, we will count the first two races sailed in the regatta.

Pine Lake Regatta sponsored by CYC at Charlevoix on June 27

1 race scheduled to be scored

No Boundaries Regatta sponsored by CYC at Charlevoix on August 8

1 race scheduled to be scored

Red Fox Regatta sponsored by CYC at Charlevoix on September 5 & at Boyne City on September 6

2 races scheduled to be scored

Last Chance Regatta sponsored by BCYC at Boyne City on September 26 & 27

2 races scheduled to be scored

Events will be governed by the Notice of Races and the Sailing Instructions for each Regatta. Corrected finish times for the races specified will be used to determine a boats finish position for purposes of scoring in this Series.

2 race scores will be dropped and 6 of 8 scores will be counted. In the event any races are cancelled, the number of scores to be counted will be reduced by each race cancelled.

2 Fleets are planned; Jib and Main (JAM), and Spinnaker.

The low point scoring system of Appendix A of the RRS will be used. Rule A9 will be used to determine scoring points. Rule A8 will be used to break any scoring ties.

Results will be emailed to registered participants after each scored event

Flags will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place finishes in each fleet. Flags will be awarded after the Last Chance Regatta. **If fewer than 4 boats register in a fleet, flags will be awarded for 1 position less than the number of boats registered.**

A perpetual Trophy will be engraved with the winners of each fleet and will reside at the Clubhouse of the winning boat of each fleet, beginning with the JAM fleet on odd numbered years , and the Spinnaker fleet on even numbered years. The trophy will be awarded at the Awards Ceremony of the Yacht Club of the winning JAM boat on odd numbered years and the winning Spinnaker boat on even numbered years.
