## Charlevoix Yacht Club Spring, Summer and Fall Thursday Night Race Series Notice of Races 2022

## 1.0 Notice of Races

- 1.1. Charlevoix Yacht Club will be conducting the Thursday Night Race Series on the dates listed below. The races will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), 2021 to 2024, as adopted by U.S. Sailing and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. Boats competing in these races may only be registered by Members of the Charlevoix Yacht Club, and Junior Members whose parents are Members.
- 1.3. There will be a skipper's meeting at the Charlevoix Yacht Club on April 29th, at 5:30 P.M; a supplementary meeting may be schedule immediately prior to the Summer Series (first race June 29<sup>th</sup>)
- 1.4. The Summer Series will consist of 8 Thursday nights. If more than 8 races are scored 2 "throw outs" are allowed; for every 4 additional races one additional throw out is allowed. Racing starts Thursday June 30th through August 18th.
- 1.5. The Fall Series will consist of 7 Thursday nights. If more than 8 races are scored 2 "throw outs" are allowed; for every 4 additional races one additional throw out is allowed. Racing starts with Thursday, August 25th through October 6th.
- 1.6. The registration fee for the Summer Series is \$325.00, and Fall \$215.00. Discounted fees are available for US Sailing Members. If you are sailing in both Wednesday and Thursdays, an additional fee is required. A signed Entry Form and fees are due the day of the first race to be sailed. A yacht will be scored DNC for any race in which the entry fees have not been paid. Registration form can be downloaded from the CYC website. www.CharlevoixYachtClub.org
- 1.7. Sailing instructions will be available online prior to racing at the CYC website www.CharlevoixYachtClub.org
- 1.8. Notices to competitors will be posted on the front window of the Yacht Club building, 220 Ferry Avenue and online.

## 2.0 Scoring

- 2.1. Finish places will be determined by the race committee
- 2.2. Series a. For series standings, points will be awarded in accordance with "Low Point" scoring system of Appendix A of (RRS). b. A yacht must start a minimum of 4 races to be scored for a series.
- 2.3. Flags will be awarded to the First, Second and Third place boats in each fleet, in each series, based on total points for each series. If fewer than 4 boats register in a fleet, flags will be awarded for 2 positions less than the number of boats registered.
- 3.0 Fleets Thursday Nights are one design J/22 Fleet 45 only.

## 4.0 Courses

- 4.1. Courses to be raced will be around the buoys normally set for these races on the Northwest end of Lake Charlevoix. Courses will be windward-leeward from a start line roughly in the middle of the racing area to one of the CYC buoys
- 5.0 Changes To The Racing Rules Of Sailing
  - 5.1. Any changes to the RRS will be included in the Sailing Instructions.
