

## Amendment #2 to Summer Series SI's – July 4, 2023

### 6.0 Class Flags

6.1 Boats will be divided into fleets as follows:

(Depending on the quantity of boats to register, Fleets and splits may be subject to change before each series and will be posted at the yacht club. Also see 14.3)

Fleet	Description of Boats	Fleet Flag Color
JAM Fleet	All boats using Jib & Main Sails only	Dark Blue
Spinnaker Fleet B	Boats w/ Spinnaker-PHRF 112 & higher	Green
Spinnaker Fleet A	Boats w/ Spinnaker-PHRF 111 & lower	Light Blue
J/22 Fleet	J/22	White or J/22
Short Course Fleet A	Melges 24, J/70, E-Scow, other	Yellow

### 7.0 Courses

7.3 The J/22 Fleet and Short Course Fleet A will sail short windward-leeward courses to an inflatable mark. Multiple races will be held each night if possible. The number of legs for each race will be displayed on the Race Committee Boat in RED next to the J/22 logo.

### 8.0 Marks

8.2 The Short Course Fleet A and J/22 fleet will use an inflatable mark for their windward and leeward mark, color and shape vary. The leeward mark will also be the start and finish mark for the Short Course fleets.

### 9.0 The Start

9.4 The stating signal times are scheduled as follows, but the Race Committee flag signals shall govern, regardless of the starting time:

### 10.0 The Finish

10.1 The finish line for the JAM, Spinnaker B and Spinnaker A will be between the staff displaying the Blue flag on the committee boat and the nearby mark of the course.

### 14.0 Scoring

14.2.4 J/22 and Short Course Fleet A scoring will allow for 2 “throw-outs” after 8 races completed, plus an additional “throw-out” for every 4 additional races completed.
